Scientific Rationale for "Inflammoncology Contest"

The field of dermatology is currently undergoing a profound transformation, driven by the translational revolution, which bridges the gap between laboratory discoveries and clinical applications.

This revolution has reshaped both the inflammatory and oncological branches of dermatology, empowering clinicians with advanced tools to offer more targeted, personalized treatments. While traditionally treated as separate entities, chronic inflammatory skin diseases and cutaneous oncology are now understood to have significant points of overlap, particularly regarding the role of inflammation in cancer progression. The Inflammoncology Contest has been created with the goal of fostering synergy between these two critical fields, through an engaging and competitive format designed for European dermatology residents.

The contest challenges participants to engage in both inflammatory and oncological scenarios, with the aim of strengthening the connection between these branches of dermatology. Teams of residents will face clinical and theoretical challenges, allowing them to showcase their knowledge and decision-making skills in the management of complex cases that often straddle the line between chronic inflammation and skin cancer.

The Inflammoncology Contest is not only about sharpening diagnostic and therapeutic skills; it is designed to cultivate a mindset of transversality. Dermatology residents will be encouraged to think beyond traditional boundaries, drawing connections between inflammatory and oncological mechanisms to devise comprehensive treatment strategies. This contest exemplifies the belief that the greatest advances in medicine occur when we step outside of compartmentalized thinking and make interdisciplinary connections. By engaging in this event, participants will play an active role in shaping the future of dermatology, where the synergy between inflammation and oncology will continue to drive therapeutic innovations.

Ultimately, the Inflammoncology Contest aims to inspire the next generation of dermatologists to embrace the integration of these two fields, fostering collaboration, innovation, and the development of novel therapies that will improve patient outcomes across a spectrum of dermatologic conditions.
